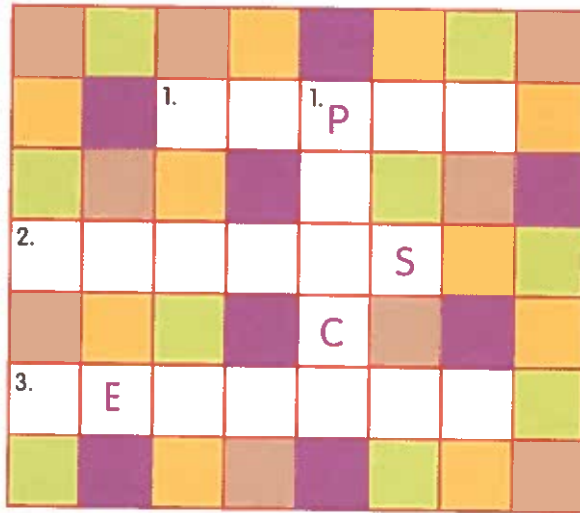

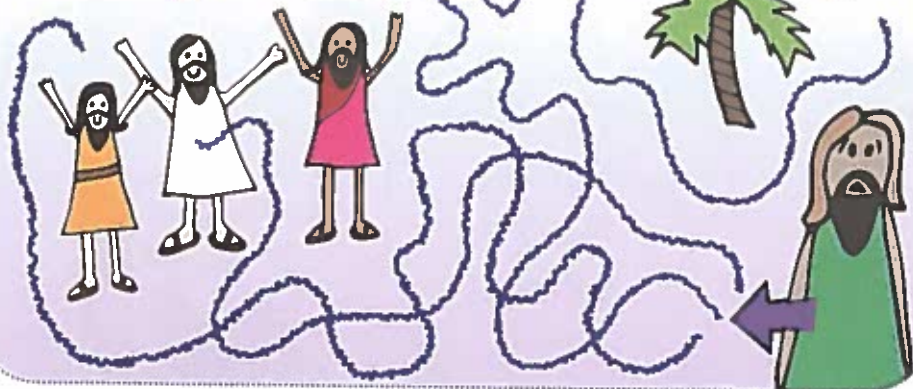

Spread peace!

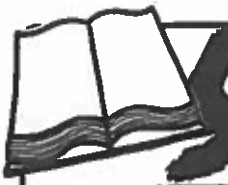
We use symbols to help us to think about the Holy Spirit.

Father God, thank you for giving us your Holy Spirit who gives us strength and courage. Help me to use these gifts to be a true friend to you and to other people. Amen.



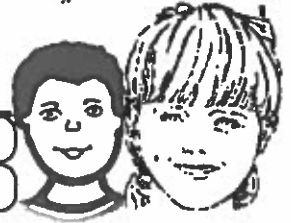
