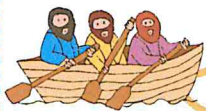
## IN THE GOSPEL TODAY

Jesus and his friends rowed across the lake to find a quiet place to rest.

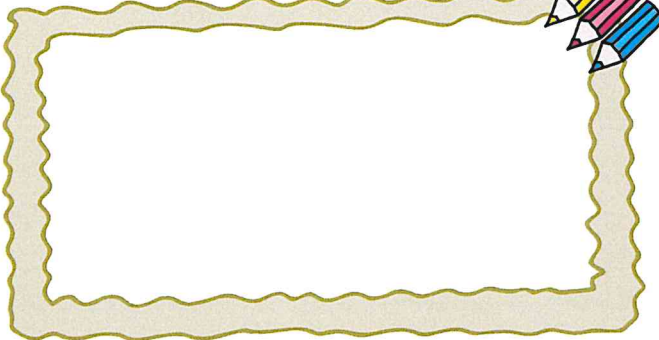

Answers: Which is the quietest? snowflake, bird, cat, trumpet, whistle.



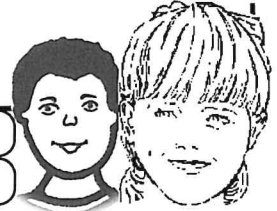

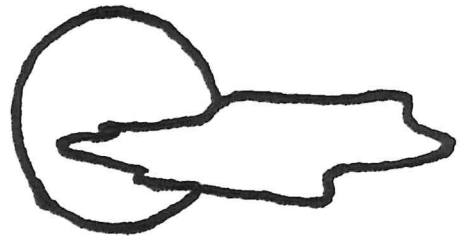
