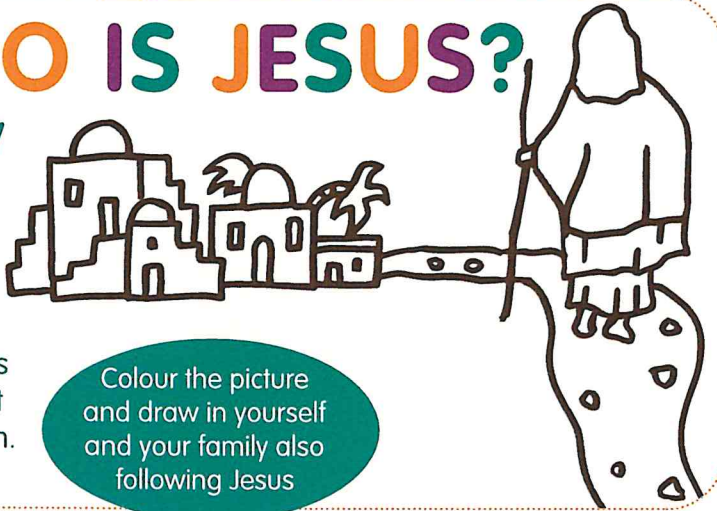
My name is _____

Follow God!

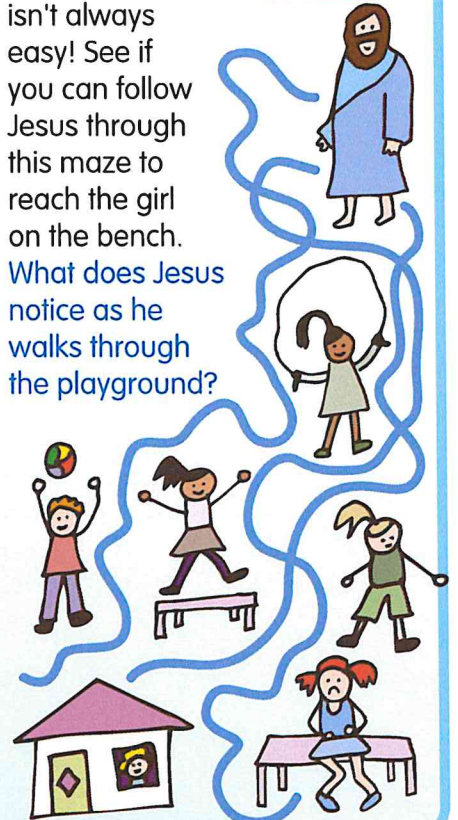
Jesus has gone on ahead on the road. His friends want to follow him.

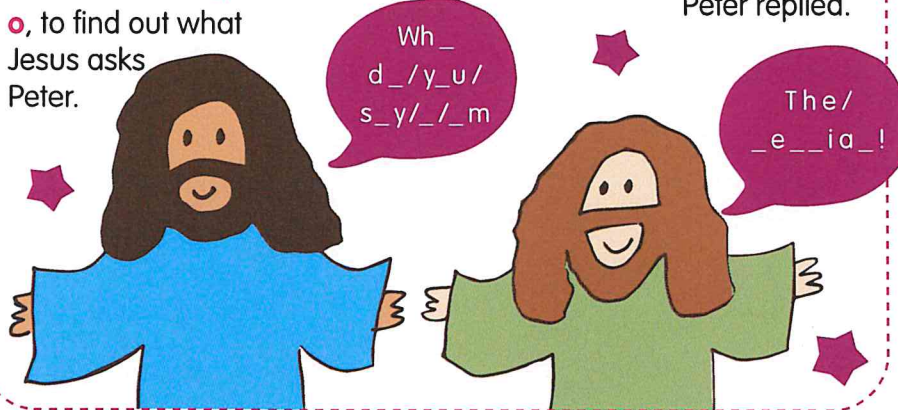
What does Jesus notice as he walks through the playground?

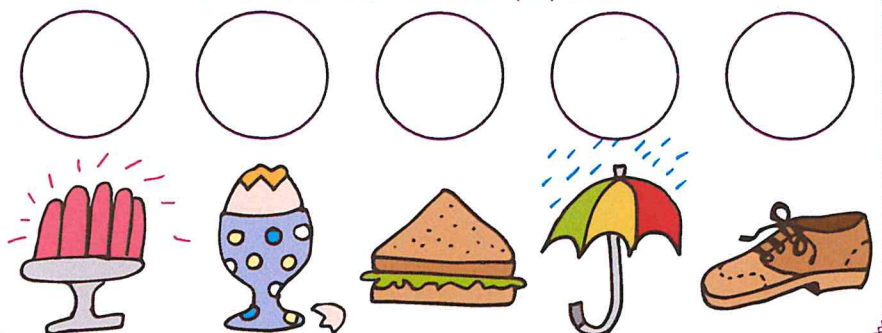
Add the vowels **a** or **o**, to find out what Jesus asks Peter.
