Dear Jesus, thank you for showing me how to be happy. Help me to spread your joy and happiness by being kind and loving to everyone I meet. Amen.



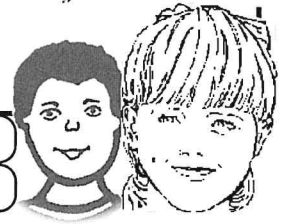
